## Public transport

### Underground

The closest Underground station is Angel on the Northern line (no step-free access) - 0.4 miles Barbican Underground station has access to Metropolitan, Hammersmith and City and Circle lines - 0.7 miles

#### Bus

Angel Gate is very well served by buses from all over London with many routes stopping right outside in either Goswell Road or City Road. The nearest stop is "Goswell Road /Earlstoke Estate", served by routes 4 and 56.

## Driving

Angel Gate lies just within the London Congestion Charge Zone - shaded red on map opposite. To avoid paying the charge approach from the north, west or east and choose a car park in the non-shaded area.

Car Parks: Long-Term (approx. £8 per day) at Elia Mews (via Nelson Terrace) and Budget Parking Theseus Walk (via City Garden Row). There is some short-term metered parking in Graham Street.
