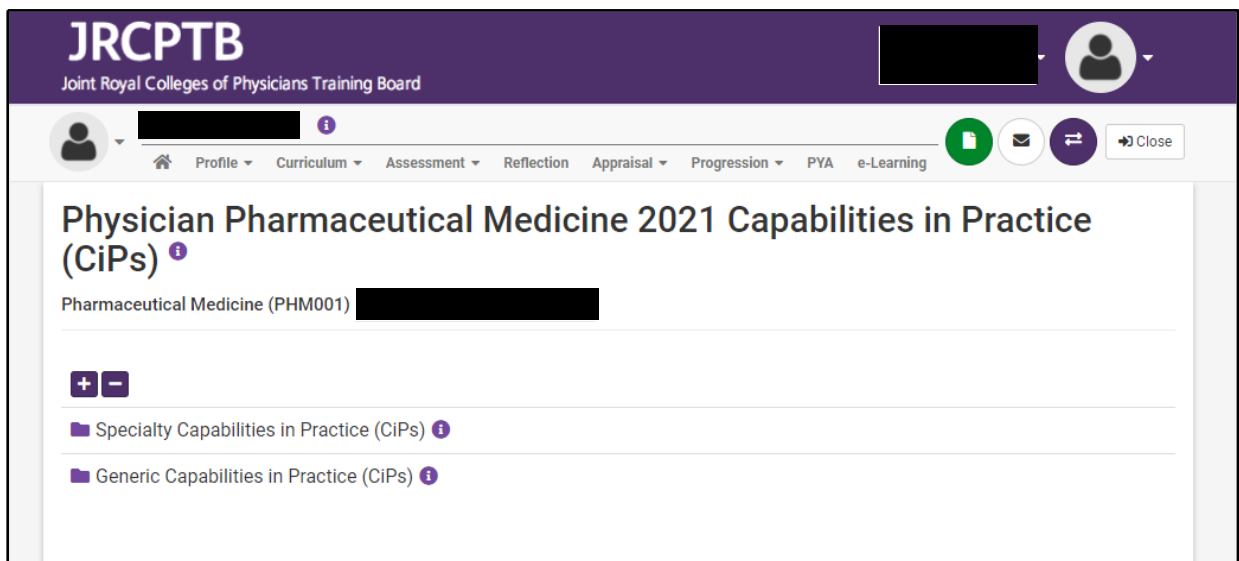
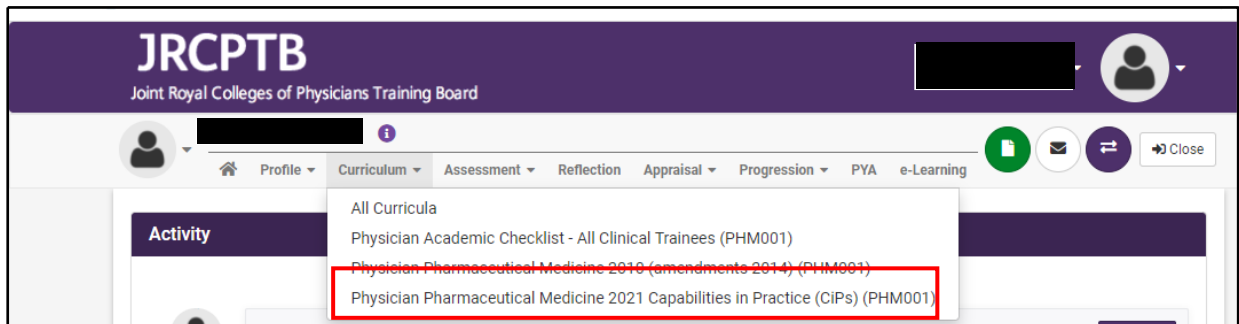




Quick guide to the trainee e-portfolio for trainees following the new 2021 PMST curriculum

1. The new 2021 PMST curriculum

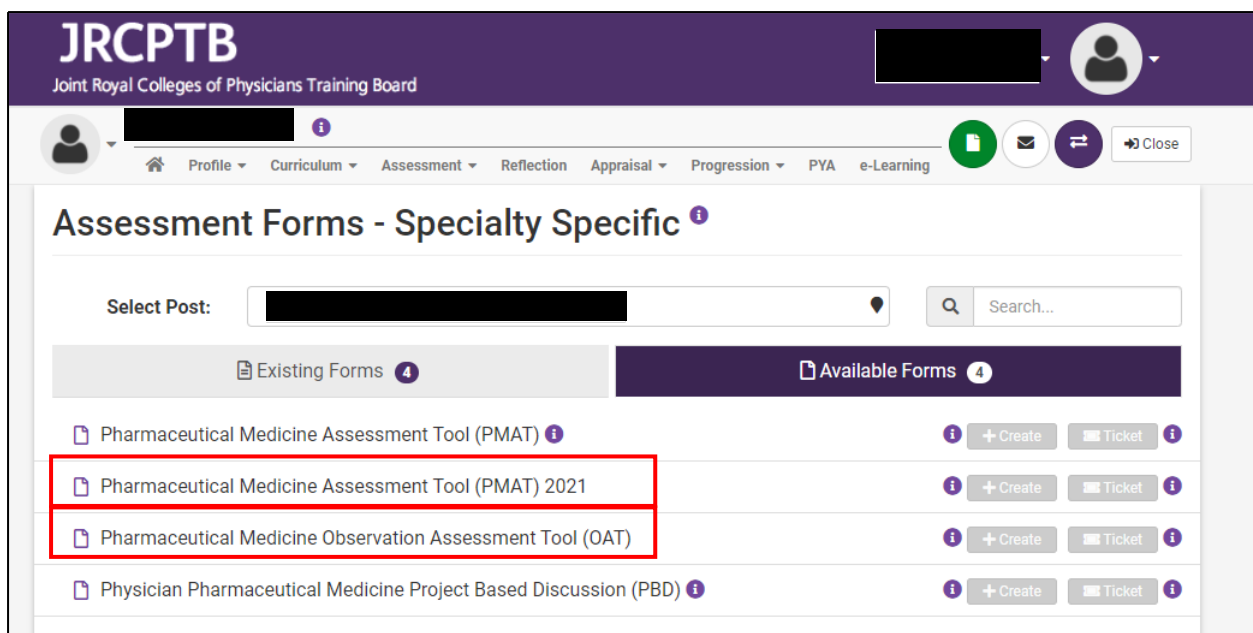
Trainees who are following the new 2021 PMST curriculum must link all their evidence, reflective practice commentaries and workplace-based assessments to the 'Physician Pharmaceutical Medicine 2021 Capabilities in Practice (CiPs) (PHM001)' on their e-portfolio.



2. The workplace-based assessments and MSF of the new curriculum

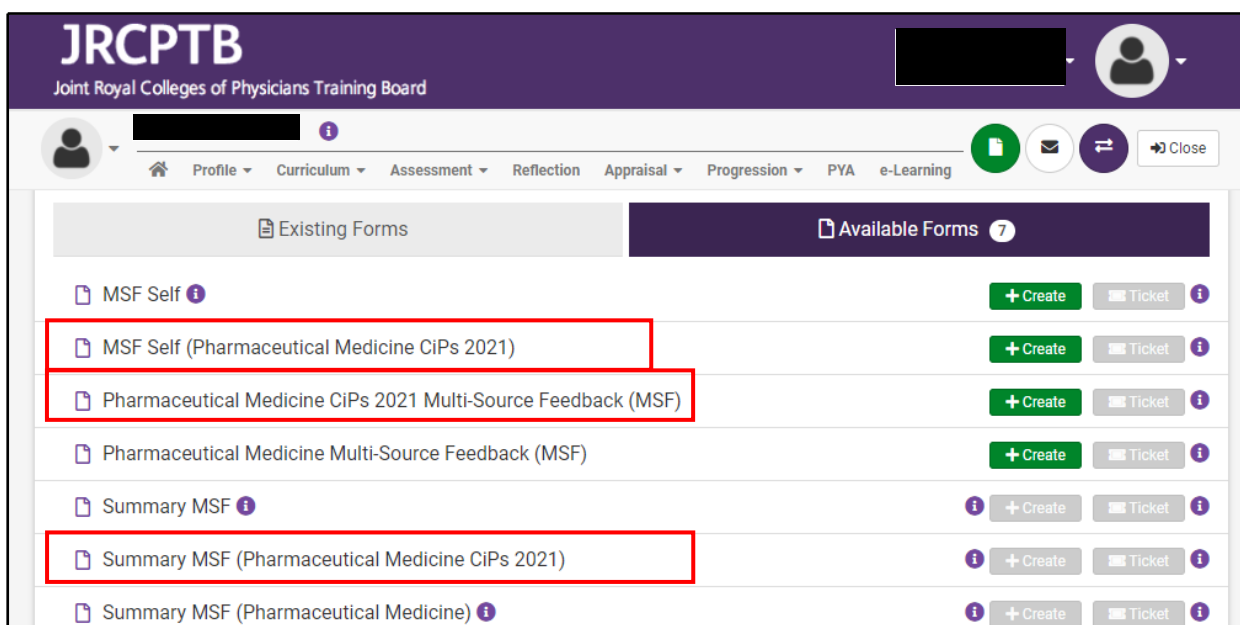
Trainees must use the workplace-based assessments (WPBAs) associated with the new 2021 PMST curriculum only. The WPBAs are:

- Pharmaceutical Medicine Assessment Tool (PMAT) 2021
- Pharmaceutical Medicine Observation Assessment Tool (OAT)



Trainees and their educational supervisors must use the following MSF questionnaires and forms only:

- MSF Self (Pharmaceutical Medicine CiPs 2021)
- Pharmaceutical Medicine CiPs 2021 Multi-Source Feedback (MSF)
- Summary MSF (Pharmaceutical Medicine CiPs 2021) – created by the educational supervisor
